SUBJECT: KSC ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

1. PURPOSE

This Instruction establishes policy and assigns responsibility for the management and implementation of environmental activities at the Kennedy Space Center (KSC).

2. APPLICABILITY AND SCOPE

This Instruction applies to all KSC organizational elements and, to the extent provided in the applicable contracts, to KSC and NASA contractors and subcontractors working on KSC and Cape Canaveral Air Force Station (CCAFS). It also applies to tenants within the geographical boundaries of KSC. This Instruction applies to all KSC environmental programs, excluding radioactive materials.

*3. AUTHORITY

NPD 8500.1 (as revised), "NASA Environmental Management"

4. POLICY

It is KSC policy to use all practical means to protect and enhance the quality of the environment, consistent with statutory and regulatory authority, NASA directives, Executive Orders, KSC Environmental Policy and available resources.

*5. RESPONSIBILITIES

- a. The Director of Spaceport Services is responsible for the implementation of Environmental Programs and Activities on KSC.
- b. The Chief, Environmental Program Branch, is responsible for managing the KSC Environmental Program. These responsibilities include coordination and integration of all environmental programs, all formal contact with environmental regulatory agencies, remediation of contaminated sites, cease and desist authority for all polluting activities, and compliance monitoring and surveillance. To execute these responsibilities, the Environmental Program Branch is established.
- c. Heads of primary organizations, all tenant organizations assigned to KSC, and all Program and Project Offices are responsible for the environmental performance of their organization.

6. IMPLEMENTATION

Detailed policy and procedures will be contained in KHB 8800.6, KSC Environmental Control Handbook, Kennedy Documented Procedures (KDPs) and Environmental Policy Letters which will be filed in the Center's Official Environmental Program files and available on the KSC Environmental Branch Home Page.

7. SUPERSESSION

This Instruction supersedes KMI 8800.8 Revision A, dated June 18, 2000.
