

Recycling at KSC Reclamation Yard:

The Reutilization, Marketing, and Recycling Facility (RMRF) will accept items for recycling, reuse, and resale (KSC form 7-49) at the Reclamation Yard, M6-1671.

Examples include: Appliances, computers, carpet, reusable pallets and lumber, scrap metal, tires and other miscellaneous tools, pumps, motors, etc. POC Brian Kilcommons, 861-8795.

Recycling at the KSC Landfill:

The KSC Landfill will accept items for disposal that can not be recycled. Construction and Demolition (C&D) debris such as concrete, segregated green waste, and untreated wood is diverted to recycling staging area.

Drop Your Chemicals Off Here (DYCOH) Program:

The DYCOH program provides KSC tenant organizations with an option to dispose of certain small quantity waste products and universal wastes by delivering the waste to a designated collection facility, K7-115. Batteries, fluorescent lamps and aerosol cans are recycled through the DYCOH.

Mixed Office Paper Recycling

Empty blue desk-side totes into large bins inside the buildings

- All white and colored bond paper
- Post-it notes
- Drafting paper
- Stapled and paper clipped material
- Manila and colored file folders
- Notebook paper
- Adding machine paper
- Computer paper with green bars
- Business cards
- All envelopes with or without windows
- Stationary with or without colored ink/letterhead
- Non-coated office newsletters such as KSC Bulletin, Spaceport News
- Fax paper (plain paper or thermal)
- Softbound/Note books
- KSC telephone directories

Non-mixed Paper Recycling

- **Sensitive documents** -- deposit sensitive information documents into slotted locked bins (Progressive Document Destruction) located throughout various facilities
- **Shredded paper** -- deposit shreds into slotted locked bins marked "Sensitive Information Only."

Other Paper Not recycled (office trash)

- Tissue paper
- Coated or "slick" paper
- Copy or bond paper wrappers

Toner Cartridges

- Deposit printer/copier cartridges in the green bins. If you require a pickup for your area or need a green bin please contact Cartridge Source of America at 267-7726.
- Please do not place any Xerox Copier toner cartridges in the green bins. Leave all Xerox Copier toner cartridges adjacent to the copy machines for pickup. For Xerox questions call 867-9110
- USA Employees, place copier/printer cartridges adjacent to the copier for pickup

Cardboard and Other Recycling

Deposit cardboard and items listed below in the dumpsters outside large facilities labeled "Cardboard Only."

- Cardboard- all sizes broken down
- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Notepads
- Spiral bound notebooks
- Booklets and brochures



Note: Small boxes can be placed inside near trash containers. Do not deposit packing material in the cardboard recycling container.

Glass, Aluminum and Plastic (GAP)



All personnel on KSC are encouraged to take their empty GAP containers and place them in the proper container. These are the blue containers located in various facilities throughout KSC.

Acceptable materials:

Plastic

- Containers with narrow necks only
- Only empty containers with no caps or lids; labels OK
- No plastic bags, plastic food trays or Styrofoam products.

Aluminum

- Empty aluminum cans only
- No steel cans in recycling stations

Glass

- Empty glass drink containers only; no lids; labels OK

***Containers that previously held hazardous materials such as pesticides or petroleum products are NOT acceptable.*
