

## Drop Your Chemicals Off Here (DYCOH) Program

Do you have a can or bottle of a chemical product that you no longer use? MESC Waste Management provides a streamlined program for disposal of small quantities of unused chemical products and universal wastes. Examples include expired laboratory chemicals, paints, adhesives, aerosol cans, fluorescent lamps, batteries (including alkaline), and mercury-containing articles. Please note that exposed contacts must be taped on **all batteries** to prevent short circuiting. Materials must be in 5 gallon containers or less, accompanied by an MSDS, and must have an aggregate volume of 15 gallons or less. The program is for government-owned materials and not intended for household wastes. Suitable materials can be dropped off at Facility K7-0115, located on Fluids Servicing Road, in the Propellants North area of KSC. Customers must first sign-in at building K7-0418, proceed to K7-0115, and leave materials with the attendant. If the materials are associated with Shuttle Transition and Retirement program, please advise the attendant. Materials are accepted only from 1300-1400 on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
